



Westglen Swim Club Pool Rule and Guidelines

General Pool Rules

- A. Please read pool rules and safety signs posted in the pool area.
- B. Lifeguards are the authority concerning pool safety always.
- C. Anyone (including adults) disobeying the rules, ignoring the lifeguard's instructions or endangering the safety of any other person will be asked to leave the pool area. Repeat violator may result in suspension of pool privileges for up to the remainder of season by having their pool tag revoked.
- D. All members will present their pool membership tags upon entry to the lifeguard on duty.
- E. All guests of members will need to sign in at the entry gate by their sponsoring member. No more than three guests will be allowed per resident membership along with a \$3.00 entry fee per guest. Fee will be collected at the gate upon entry.
- F. Moving of pool umbrellas/umbrella stands will be prohibited. All furniture and umbrellas are first come first serve.
- G. No pushing patrons into the pool.
- H. No running allowed in pool area.
- I. No excessive "horseplay" in pool area.
- J. No diving where designated. Flips or inward dives are prohibited from the sides of pool.
- K. No glass containers of any kind in the pool area.
- L. No beverages or food allowed in the pool always.
- M. No Smoking allowed in pool, only in DESIGNATED AREA in parking lot.
- N. No profanity of any kind will be allowed in pool.
- O. Abusive language or gestures by anyone in the pool area will be asked to leave the premises by the pool staff.
- P. No loud, offensive music will be allowed in the pool area by anyone. Respect those around you.
- Q. Fighting in and around the pool area will not be tolerated. Violators are subject to suspension of pool privileges.
- R. No pets in the pool area.
- S. No cutoffs or street clothes are allowed in pool area due to county health violation.
- T. Use of flotation devices/toys will be at the discretion of the lifeguards. Size and number of devices will be based on the number of patrons in the pool. This includes any water/bath toys, Nerf balls, squirt guns, rafts, tubes, noodles, kick boards and any other toys. Large toy/flotation devices will not be allowed. If the behavior of a swimmer using any water toy endangers the safety of others, the offending swimmer will be asked by the lifeguard to remove the toy from the pool.
- U. All persons must be clean before entering the pool. Showers are available in bathrooms.
- V. All swimmers under 10 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult over the age of 18.
- W. All patrons are subject to a swim test at the discretion of the lifeguard.
- X. If requested, one swim lane may be designated for lap swimming only. Non-lap swimmers may not swim into or across the lap lane.
- Y. Swimmers are not allowed to hang on to the ropes separating the deep end.
- Z. All "private parties" need to be schedule and paid through the pool management company. Forms available.

Baby Pool Rules

- a. **Lifeguards are NOT assigned to supervise the baby pool.** Parents and/or guardians are responsible for their own children while using the baby pool.
- b. Parents and/or guardians must accompany their children into and out of the baby pool. You will be asked to leave if you do not supervise your children.
- c. Only non-swimming children 5 years and under are allowed in the baby pool other than parents and/or guardians.
- d. Minimum age to supervise a child in the baby pool is 14 years old.
- e. All pool rules apply to the baby pool.
- f. Swimwear is required.
- g. Disposables diapers are not allowed in either pool. **Swim diapers or rubber pants are required. Failure to have these items, your child will not be allowed in pool.**
